

As part of each sponsorship package, each sponsor will receive lead capture access through Cvent.



### **Presentations**

All sessions run for 40 minutes (Platinum and Gold) or 30 minutes (Silver) in length, with the presentation recommended to allow for question time.

- Data<sup>#</sup>3 Staff to provide a Top and Tail, and facilitate Q&A. This person is being organised by Data<sup>#</sup>3.
- All breakout rooms will have a laptop (Windows based), lectern, fold-back screens (current slide, presenter notes and countdown), microphone and sound system as part of the set-up. Should a presenter wish to utilise their own laptop (such as a MAC), it is the presenter's responsibility to ensure the appropriate connections accompany the device.
- All presentations need to be sent to Cassie at Data#3 at least 3 days prior along with a PDF version you would like shared with delegates after the event. It is recommended that each presenter bring their presentation on a USB on the day of the event to the allocated speaker room. While Data#3 will hold all presentations provided, if any last minute changes are made to presentations, these will need to be managed from an external source such as a USB or hard drive.
- A speaker presenter room is available in each location.

## Venue Food approvals & electrical items

#### **FOOD**

Exhibitors at Food & Beverage related events wishing to provide samples at BCEC must obtain prior approval from the Food & Beverage Management.

When food or drink samples are given away for promotional purposes:

- They must be offered in such a manner as to avoid being handled by the public e.g. portioned and toothpicks inserted.
- They should be protected from contamination, for example by the use of trays fitted with plastic covers.
- Condiments such as sauces and mustards are to be contained in squeeze type dispensers or individual sealed packets.
- For other than food related exhibitions, cooking of food by Exhibitors is prohibited unless approved by the Centre. Early consultation with the BCEC Management is mandatory.
- Exhibitors must provide receptacles for rubbish collection. These receptacles must be located within or near to the stand and the contents shall be disposed of in a manner approved by Centre Management.
- Sampling request form must be filled out and sent back by the 18th March

#### **ELECTRICAL**

- All electrical devices outside of what Outstanding Displays are suppling will need to have been electrical tested and tagged: All electrical equipment entering an AVM venue must display up to date testing and tagging in accordance with the relevant Australian/New Zealand standards.
- Double adaptors, and piggy backing from distribution boards is prohibited from use onsite. The practice of piggy backing at electrical lead ends is
  also restricted.


